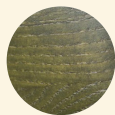

Timber:

Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth. Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap solution, wiping along the grain. Avoid excessive moisture. Position away from direct sunlight or use window coverings to reduce fading and movement. Maintain a stable environment to minimise warping or cracking. Blot spills immediately. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.

Warranty

Warranty period is 24 months from date of purchase.

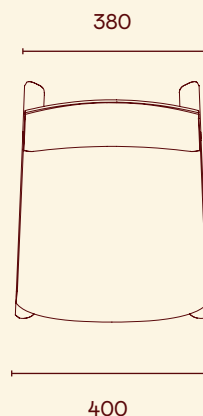
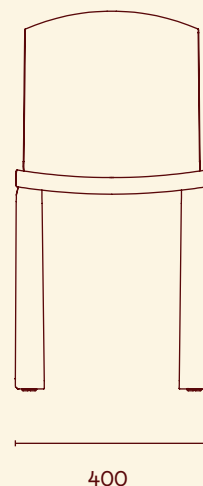
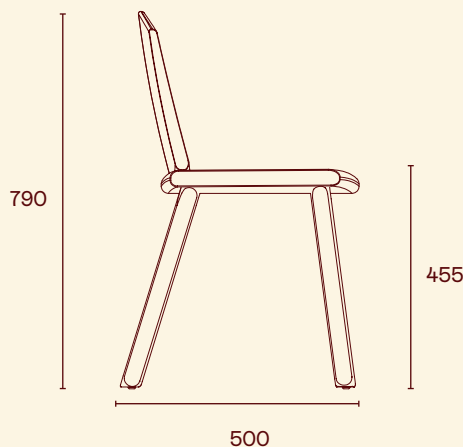
